FIND MY BUS STOP . . . BUS STOP FINDER

Busing information is at your fingertips. Simply access **STEO's website** at www.steo.ca and click on the "Find My Bus Stop" icon.

Fill in your information for secure access to your child's route number, pick-up time and location, bus company name and phone number.


Parents or students confirming busing information require an OEN number (found on the student report card). Kindergarten students or NEW students that have not yet been assigned an OEN number can use the School Assigned Student ID number until an OEN number is provided. Please reach out to your school before the school year ends for your Student ID number.

You can check busing information beginning August 20, 2024. A reminder that drivers will not be calling out to families with busing information to avoid missed/misdirected calls and to ensure that families are accessing the most accurate information available.

CAN I RIDE A BUS?

The **School and Transportation Eligibility** tool is active for the **2024 – 2025** school year.

Which School do I attend AND Can I ride a bus?


Pick the 2024 – 2025 School Year before clicking on "School Information", "School Eligibility: Which School do I attend?" or "Transportation Eligibility: Can I Ride a Bus?"

- **School Information:** Provides the address, phone number, website, boundary map, and available programs and grades for a chosen school.
- **School Eligibility: Which School do I Attend?** Allows a student, parent, guardian, or school staff to check for school eligibility based on the address entered.

Parents and guardians can use the Parent Portal to check pick-up and drop-off information once bus routes are created. The Parent Portal also allows parents to subscribe to receive bus delay and cancellation emails throughout the school year.

To change the **School Year** for any of the options above, click on the HOME menu option and re-select the appropriate **School Year** from the drop-down list, as highlighted above.

The 2024 – 2025 Parent Portal/BUS STOP FINDER **will be active on August 20, 2024.**

After August 20, 2024, bus route updates may occur until the start of school year. **Please check back frequently for updates after August 20, 2024, as route information can change up until school begins.**

MOVING OR CHANGING DAYCARES?

Inform your child's school of address/contact information changes as soon as you can and before the end of the school year, if possible, to ensure that busing is set up for the first day of school.
